**Items Accepted at no charge:** Almost anything with a cord or battery...

- Computing Equipment
  - computer servers
  - desktop computers
  - laptops
  - Peripherals including docking stations and USB drives
  - external hard drives
  - computer monitors (see below)
- Office Equipment
  - fax machines
  - copiers
  - laminators
  - office phone systems
  - scanners
- Cords
  - Extension Cord
  - Power strips
  - charging cords for cell phones
  - USB cables
  - HDMI or other video cables
  - coaxial cables
  - CAT5/6 cables
  - Basically, yes...
- Household items
  - electric card shuffler's
  - home phones (corded or not)
  - cell phones, ranging from new iPhones to old brick units
  - electric toothbrushes
  - DVD players
  - VCRS
  - Reel-to-reel players
  - stereo equipment
  - flat screen tvs/monitors
  - Bluetooth speakers
  - coffee makers
  - toasters
  - lamps
  - flashlights
  - window air conditioning units
  - typewriters
  - digital cameras
  - microwaves
  - The list is endless...

**Items Accepted for a fee (cash, check, Venmo, or Zelle):**

- CRT/Tube/Projection Monitors and TVs: \$20 each
- Certificates of Destruction for computers, laptops, hard drives, etc.:
  - General COD for the event: no charge
  - Standard COD (a count/list of items destroyed for the customer): \$15 per unit
  - Serialized COD (a list of make, model, and serial # of each unit destroyed): \$25 per unit

**Items NOT Accepted:**

- Loose batteries: rechargeable or alkaline (lead and lithium are okay)
- Anything containing hazardous waste (X-Ray tubes, engines, etc.) – hasn't been an issue yet
- Anything with a compressed gas canister – propane stoves, oxygen tanks, etc.
- No items larger than 1 cubic yard – e.g. Refrigerators, washer/dryers, ellipticals
